PROTECT MARINE LIFE - AVOID FUEL SPILLS

Each year, Harbor Staff respond to many incidents involving fuel spilled into the water. We want to be good stewards of the environment so please consider these guidelines:

- Be careful when leaving portable gas tanks and hoses in the hot sun.
 Outboard style fuel tanks and hoses will leak due to fuel expansion in the hot summer sun.
- No fueling over the dock. Fueling

may only occur at designated fueling docks.

- All spills should be reported to the Harbor Office and the US Coast Guard's National Response Center at 1-800-424-8802.
- Reporting spills in a timely manner ensures that clean-up can be initiated as soon as possible, allowing us to keep our harbors and surrounding waters clean.

BRIEFLY INFORMATIVE

DO NOT DISCHARGE SEWAGE

The marinas are No Discharge Harbors. Empty your port-a-potty or holding tank at one of the convenient pump-outs located throughout both harbors. Operating instructions are available at each pump-out station. Please contact the Harbor Office if you have any questions on how to operate the pump-out; Squalicum Office: (360) 676-2542 or Blaine Office: (360) 647-6176.

DO NOT STORE ITEMS ON THE DOCKS

Please do not store items such as kayaks, canoes, bikes, dock carts or crab pots on the docks. These items are a trip hazard to your fellow boaters and to first responders who may need to access the docks. Small docksteps that can be stored aboard your vessel when not in use are allowed.

STATE BOATER REGISTRATION STICKERS REQUIRED TO AVOID FINES

Make sure to get your 2013 Washington State registration sticker displayed correctly aboard your vessel to prevent fines. The Whatcom County Sheriff will be patrolling the harbors for out-of-date registration stickers this year. More information on proper display of registration can be found at www.boat.wa.gov

PARTICIPATE IN LOAN-A-SLIP

Consider making your slip available to visiting boaters or a friend through the loan-a-slip program.

MOORAGE AVAILABLE IN BLAINE HARBOR

Blaine Harbor has moorage availability for 36, 40, and 50 foot boats. If you know someone who is considering getting a new boat, send them our way.

RINSE STATION TO RECEIVE UPGRADES

This fall we will make upgrades to the Blaine boat launch rinse station. The project will include a new rinse pad and infrastructure to collect boat rinse water, which will be diverted to the sanitary sewer when the water hose is activated. We expect the project to begin in October. During project construction, the rinse station will not be available, however there is a self-serve car wash in downtown Blaine that is available.

Watching the Regatta

If you plan to watch the racing action, here are some helpful tips that can make your spectator experience and the racers' experience safe and enjoyable.

- Spectator boats should be at least 100 yards away from a racing vacht.
- Spectator boats should avoid placing themselves between the wind and the racing boats, and never in front or behind the start/ finish line.

KEEP GATES CLOSED AND REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

In an effort to provide a safe, and secure harbor, we encourage you to keep gates closed and not propped open, and to report suspicious activity, or items that may pose a safety risk to our boaters and visitors. RETURN DOCK CARTS TO DESIGNATED AREAS AT GATE ENTRANCES

Please remember to return dock carts to the head of the gate or the comfort station on Gate 3. If you would like a cart for your own use rather than share, consider purchasing a folding dock cart to store on-board. We all appreciate the use of a cart and, when they are left on the dock, it makes for limited availability.
