



NOTICE OF TARIFF AMENDMENTS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023

The Port of Bellingham has approved rate adjustments for the Bellingham Shipping Terminal Tariff No. 800. The following changes to the Port of Bellingham's Tariff No. 800 will be effective as of July 1, 2023:

- ◆ Section 1, Item 116: Security Fee will be adjusted to \$500 per vessel per 8-hour period
- ◆ Section 2, Item 208: Dockage Rates will increase 9%
- ◆ Section 2, Item 210: Fresh Water rates will increase to \$4.50/ccf
- ◆ Section 2, Item 211: Electrical Rates will increase to \$.10/kWh
- ◆ Section 2, Item 244(c): Service and Facilities Charge - Freight NOS; Logs, Softwood - will increase 6.2%
- ◆ Section 2, Item 244(c): Environmental Fees (clean up) Charge Rate will increase to \$1.50/MT
- ◆ Section 3, Item 304: Schedule of Man Hour Rates shall increase in accordance with Pacific Maritime Association's assessment and wage increases per the ILWU Pacific Coast Longshore Contract.
- ◆ Section 4, Item 400 – 403: Wharfage – NOS; Logs, Softwood; Bulk Commodities; Metals - will increase 6.2%

These updates will be posted on the Port's website at www.portofbellingham.com effective July 1, 2023. To access Tariff No. 800, find 'Maritime' and choose either 'Bellingham Shipping Terminal' or 'Rates/Tariffs' to access the updated and previous tariff rates.
